Summer Camp



The rec summer camp will be held June 25TH thru August 15TH. DT children ages five thru thirteen are eligible to enroll. Package A is for Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays and Package B is for Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please note that there is a new registration process. Online registration will be held on Tuesday, April 30TH, from 7:30 AM to 10:00 PM. Please visit dennis.recdesk.com ahead of time to setup an account and review the necessary information. Onsite registration will be held at the Rec Center on Wednesday, May 1ST, from 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM. A \$50 per child non-refundable deposit is due at registration.

Running Club

The club, open to anyone six years of age and older, will meet at the Rec Complex soccer fields on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 4:30 to 5:30 PM.

Summer Basketball

The ever popular co-ed basketball league will be held again this summer on the outdoor courts of the Rec Complex. All games will be played on weeknights during late June and all of July. DT children, **entering** grades 3RD thru 9TH are eligible to participate. Grade is determined as of September 2019. Registration will be accepted online at dennis.recdesk.com until May 20TH. Onsite registration will be accepted at the Rec Center from 3:00 to 6:00 PM on May 20TH. Fee is \$35.00 per player or \$60.00 per family. After May 20TH, anyone wishing to play will be placed on a waiting list and only added to a team if space is available and at the discretion of the assoc/rec department.
